It's hard to talk about passing on the farm. **Managing for Today and Tomorrow** is for farm women of all ages who want to plan now for a successful transition later. In this five-session program, farm women will learn about four components that can help create a successful transition:

Succession Planning transfers knowledge, labor, management, and ownership over time

- *Explore communication barriers that hold back succession planning
- *Understand the difference between fair and equal

Business Planning determines what makes up the farm business and intention for the future

- *Understand why personal and farm finances are important for business managements, succession and retirement
- *Learn how a business plan can be used for farm business development and/or transition

Estate Planning reflects the intentions of the established generation

- * Understand key estate planning terms, tools, and concepts
- * Begin assembling estate information

Retirement Planning prepares the established generation with ways to transfer responsibilities

- *Develop individual retirement definitions and goals
- * Investigate retirement options and explore sources of retirement income
