# **Richard Hawke** Keynote Address: Four-Star Plants



Richard Hawke is the plant evaluation manager at the Chicago Botanic Garden, and is responsible for the comparative evaluation of over 1200 taxa of perennials, vines, shrubs, and small trees, including the oversight of a 16,000 sq. ft. green roof trial. He is the author of *Plant Evaluation Notes*, writes for numerous horticulture publications, is a contributing editor for *Fine Gardening*, and teaches and lectures frequently. Richard received the Perennial Plant Association's Academic Award for teaching excellence in 2005. The Garden's Plant Evaluation Program has been recommending superior garden plants to home gardeners and the green industry since 1989. Richard will present a variety of four-star plants, including new selections and old favorites, from over 25 years of comparative trials.
